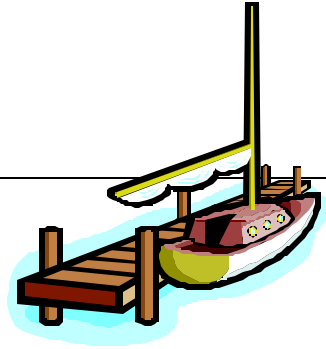

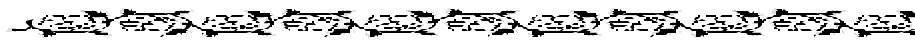

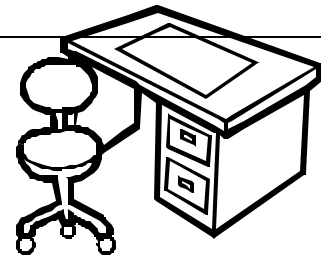

**Potluck***by Constance Borgomainerio*

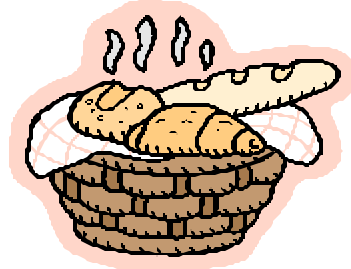
Saturday, August 29, is the last potluck before the fall season, so as we did last August, Potluck will supply ice cream sundaes for dessert.




